Maitland Conservation's Forestry Services are available to all landowners in the Maitland and Nine Mile River Watersheds. The program supplies planting stock that will produce conservation related benefits like windbreaks, stream buffers, reforestation and roadside plantings. Conditions of Ordering:

1. Applicant is responsible for the pick-up of trees at a location and time designated by MVCA.
2. Deciduous trees need be covered during transport to protect the root system. Landowners must bring a tarp for pick up.
3. Applicants will be invoiced **after** trees have been picked up. **Price subject to change depending on final tender.**
4. Applicant is responsible for the planting and care necessary for survival including adequate protection from animals.
5. Due to environmental conditions beyond the control of Maitland Conservation, we assume no responsibility for the survival rates of the trees.
