Job Description

Reporting to the Conservation Areas Coordinator, the candidate will be required to assist with the management and maintenance of Conservation Authority owned buildings and lands. Projects will include walking trail maintenance, building maintenance and reforestation site tending. Other duties may include lawn and garden care, garbage collection, painting, vehicle and equipment maintenance, and other duties as assigned.

Qualifications

- Willingness to work outdoors, occasionally under adverse weather conditions
- Ability to operate tractors, vehicles and trailers
- Ability to perform basic carpentry and properly use power tools and related equipment
- Ability to work as part of a team and/or with minimum supervision
- Good analytical, organizational and communications skills
- Valid Class G Ontario driver's license required
- Ability to lift heavy objects
- Working towards a post-secondary education in Environmental Studies, Resource Management, Forestry or related field would be an asset
- Chainsaw certification would be an asset
