

COVID19 Provincial Colour-Code Response Framework and how it applies to operations at Falls Reserve Conservation Area.

White (Shutdown)

- **Only seasonal camping is allowed under full season contract and with single household family occupancy per campsite.**
- Seasonal campsites can be open if a full season contract has been completed and all paper work submitted.
- Only campsites with electricity, water service and facilities for sewage disposal may be provided for use.
- Seasonal Campers will be required to have their own means of grey/black water transportation to the dumping station.
- All indoor facilities in the campground other than washrooms will be closed (**showers will remain closed**).
- Washrooms will be limited to single family occupancy.
- **Campground areas of the Conservation Area will be closed to the general public and no visitors will be allowed into the campgrounds.**
- **Conservation Area will remain open to permitted day-use activities by paid entry permit from sunrise to sunset. Gates will be closed at 6:00 pm daily.**
- **Outdoor gatherings may not exceed 5 people** and only if physical distancing can be maintained.
- Physical distancing must be maintained at all time from others not in your immediate household.
- Face Coverings are required while waiting in any lines and in washroom buildings.

Grey (Lockdown)

- **Only seasonal camping is allowed under full season contract and with single household family occupancy per campsite.**
- Seasonal campsites can be open if a full season contract has been completed and all paper work submitted.
- Only campsites with electricity, water service and facilities for sewage disposal may be provided for use.
- Seasonal Campers will be required to have their own means of grey/black water transportation to the dumping station.
- All indoor facilities in the campground other than washrooms will be closed (**showers will remain closed**).
- Washrooms will be limited to single family occupancy.
- **Campground areas of the Conservation Area will be closed to the general public and no visitors will be allowed into the campgrounds.**
- **Conservation Area trails will remain open to day-use by paid entry permit.**
- **Outdoor gatherings cannot exceed 10 people** and only if physical distancing can be maintained.
- Physical distancing must be maintained at all time from others not in your immediate household.
- Face Coverings are required while waiting in any lines and in washroom buildings.

Red (Control)

- **Transient camping is allowed, but encouragement of single household family occupancy per campsite.**
- Seasonal campsites can be open if a full season contract has been completed and all paper work submitted.
- Campers will be required to have their own means of grey/black water transportation to the dumping station.
- All indoor facilities in the campground will be closed other than washrooms (**Showers will remain closed**).
- Washrooms will be limited to single family occupancy.
- **Campground areas of the Conservation Area will be closed to all day-use and campsite visitors.**
- Conservation Area trails will remain open to day-use by paid entry permit.
- **Individual campsites are limited to 6 people under CA Regulations** and only if physical distancing can be maintained with those not living in the same household.
- **Group campsite can be open for 6 individual family units up to 25 people as long as physical distancing can be maintained with those not living in the same household.**
- **Outdoor gatherings cannot exceed 25 people** and only if physical distancing can be maintained.
- Physical distancing must be maintained at all times from others not in your immediate household.
- Face Coverings are required while waiting in any lines and in washroom buildings.

Orange (Restrict)

- **Transient camping is allowed, but encouragement of single household family occupancy per campsite.**
- Seasonal campsites can be open if a full season contract has been completed and all paper work submitted.
- Campers will be required to have their own means of grey/black water transportation to the dumping station.
- All indoor facilities in the campground will be closed other than washrooms (**Shower will remain closed**).
- Washrooms will be limited to single family occupancy.
- **Campground areas of the Conservation Area will be closed to all day-use.**
- **Campsite visitors by valid permit will be allowed into the campgrounds as long as site occupancy is not exceeded (Max Occupancy – 6 people).**
- Conservation Area trails will remain open to day-use by paid entry permit.
- **Individual campsites are limited to 6 people under CA Regulations** and only if physical distancing can be maintained with those not living in the same household.
- Group campsite can be open for 6 individual family units up to 25 people as long as physical distancing can be maintained with those not living in the same household.
- **Outdoor gatherings limited to 25 people** and only if physical distancing can be maintained.
- Outdoor gatherings in excess of 25 people must be an organized event and must have prior approval from the Park Superintendent.

Yellow (Protect)

- **Transient camping is allowed, but encouragement of single household family occupancy per campsite.**
- Seasonal campsites can be open if a full season contract has been completed and all paper work submitted.
- Campers will be required to have their own means of grey/black water transportation to the dumping station.
- All indoor facilities in the campground will be closed other than washrooms and showers.
- Washrooms will be limited to single family occupancy.
- **Campground areas of the Conservation Area will be closed to all day-use.**
- Campsite visitors by valid permit will be allowed into the campgrounds as long as site occupancy is not exceeded (Max Occupancy – 6 people).
- Conservation Area trails will remain open to day-use by paid entry permit.
- **Individual campsites are limited to 6 people under CA Regulations** and only if physical distancing can be maintained with those not living in the same household.
- Group campsites can be open for 6 individual family units up to 25 people as long as physical distancing can be maintained with those not living in the same household.
- **Outdoor gatherings limited to 25 people** and only if physical distancing can be maintained.

Green (Prevent)

- **Transient camping is allowed, but encouragement of single household family occupancy per campsite.**

- All indoor facilities in the campground will be closed other than washrooms and showers.
- Washrooms will be limited to single family occupancy.
- **Campground areas of the Conservation Area will be closed to all day-use.**
- Campsite visitors by valid permit will be allowed into the campgrounds as long as site occupancy is not exceeded (Max Occupancy – 6 people).
- Conservation Area trails will remain open to day-use by paid entry permit.
- **Individual campsites are limited to 6 people under CA Regulations** and only if physical distancing can be maintained with those not living in the same household.
- Group campsites can be open for 6 individual family units up to 25 people as long as physical distancing can be maintained with those not living in the same household.
- **Outdoor gatherings limited to 25 people** and only if physical distancing can be maintained.
