6. Valid Ontario G or G2 Driver's Licence.
6. Applicants with Valid Standard First Aid / CPR certification will have priority over those applicants without this certificate.

7. Police issued Criminal Record and Judicial Matters Check required (applicants aged 18 and over).

**Pay Rate:** \$15.50 per hour

Falls Reserve Conservation Area is located at 80900 Falls Reserve Line, Benmiller, Ontario; a 230-acre property situated in the Lower Maitland River Valley and consisting of 170 campsites with both seasonal and transient overnight camping and day-use amenities.

All successful applicants must possess their own Green Patch CSA approved safety boots, be able to work outdoors in all weather conditions and be available to work the duration of the season.
